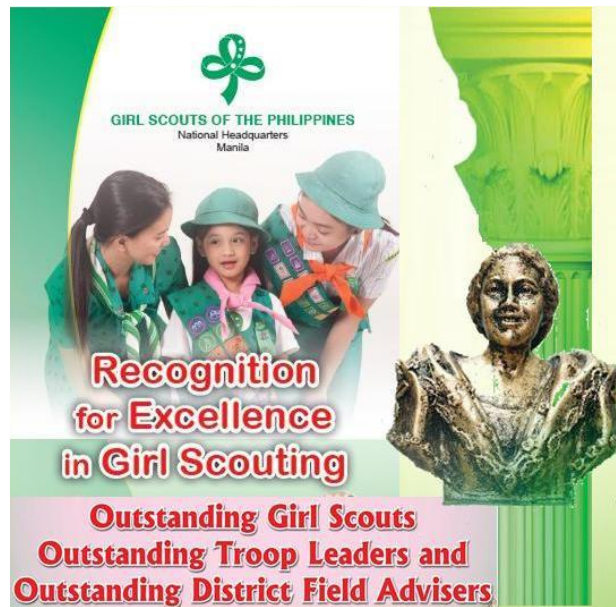

In this regard, please be informed that the Executive Committee at its meeting on June 26, 2020 has approved **the extension of the deadline of submission of documents to NHQ of the GSP Community Development Projects such as Magic Spot Projects, Pilar Hidalgo Lim Troop Achievement Award (PHLTAA), and Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme (CGSMS) for the year 2019-2020 until October 30, 2020.**




The same as well with the documents of the Recognition for Excellence in Girl Scouting namely Outstanding Girl Scouts, Outstanding Troop Leaders, and Outstanding District Field Advisers for the year 2019-2020, the submission to NHQ is also extended until **October 30, 2020.**

Further, that the PHLTAA National Evaluators shall not conduct project site visits and will only rank the nominated projects based on the documents, pictures, and videos submitted to NHQ. In case there is a need for clarifications on the project, an online interview with the troop may be conducted by the PHLTAA National Evaluators.

We hope that the extension of the deadline will help us evaluate more carefully the documents and thus continuously recognize the hard work and dedication of our Girl Scouts, Troop Leaders, District Field Advisers, and troops.
